

Northbridge Plaza Fresh Food Weekend \$20 Voucher Promotion
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter and the prize(s) form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. The promoter is Northbridge Plaza, 79-113 Sailors Bay Road, Northbridge, NSW, 2063, AMP Capital Shopping Centres Pty Limited (ABN 13 001 595 955) telephone 02 9398 9099 ("**Promoter**").
3. Entry is only open to Australian residents aged 18 years or over.
4. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, Northbridge Plaza, tenants and their employees of the promoter and agencies associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
5. This promotion will be conducted at Northbridge Plaza in Northbridge, NSW ("**Centre**").
6. Promotion commences on Monday 8 August 2022 and ends on Sunday 21 August 2022 ("**Promotional Period**").

 - c) Redemption must be in line with all terms and conditions outlined.

 - b) One use only. Customers must surrender their voucher at the time of redemption.
